- Each student wrote a letter to three people that they can count on to support them in their sobriety.

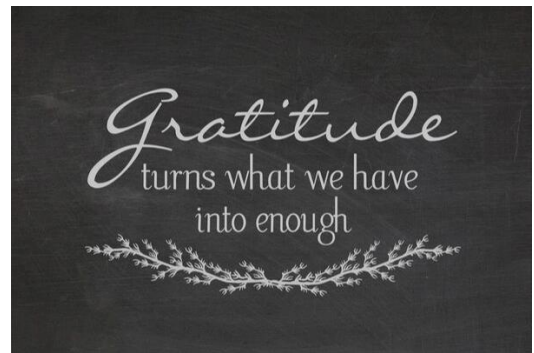
