

Classes/Services Descriptions

Walk-In and Pull-Out Speech Therapy Services:

This service is for children who have 1-2 phonological processes remaining, traditional articulation, moderate syntax, voice or fluency delays. Therapy is delivered in a small group setting (1-4 students). The child typically attends 1-2 times per week for 30 minutes, depending on the needs of the child.

The Preschool Speech Program (PSP):

This classroom serves preschool students who exhibit a disorder in the area of articulation/phonology. Phonological processing difficulties also may be impacting expressive language skills. Receptive language skills are intact, and these children appear to be developmentally appropriate in all other areas.
