Read to Succeed-Six Hour Reading Club Rules and Procedures

Read to Succeed is a free educational program sponsored by Six Flags to inspire kids to engage in reading at home. Participating students, who log six hours of reading at home and return their information are eligible to earn a free admission ticket to a participating Six Flags theme park for this summer. This program is one of the ways that this corporation supports literacy and rewards families that read at home and also is part of Wolford’s February Pack Challenge.

Here’s all you need to do to get your students reading and ready for fun at a Six Flags Theme Park!

- Students in grades K-5th are eligible to join the optional 6-Hour Reading Club.
- Students can read anything for the 6-Hour Reading Club: books, magazines, newspapers, comic books, etc. The club promotes the love of reading and rewards students and families that make reading at home part of their routines.
- Students can read books to themselves, they can read aloud to someone else, or an adult can read to them. It all counts for the club!
- Either a parent and or classroom teacher will also need to sign the form at the bottom to verify/confirm student participation.
- All students that read and document 6 hours of reading will receive a ticket for free student admission to Six Flags for this summer.
- **Student Tally sheets are due back to the Wolford Learning Commons by Wednesday, FEBRUARY 27th, 2019.**
- The Learning Commons will accept completed tally sheets **prior** to the due date. Also, participating students will be recognized in a school display highlighting their achievements.
- **Entries that are received late or that contain missing information will be considered void.**
- During the month of May, the staff will deliver the free Six Flags tickets to participating students along with other end of the school year certificates.
