

Wolford Elementary Face-To-Face Instruction Practices & Protocols

MORNING SCREENING AT HOME

Per the MISD student handbook, parents will be required to screen their child daily for COVID-19 symptoms before sending them to school daily

ARRIVAL 7:30-8:00 AM

Arrival locations will remain the same as in previous years
There are some changes for Kindergarten students from Sept. 3 through Sept. 11
Kindergarten teachers will inform parents of these changes

BREAKFAST 7:15-7:50 AM

Breakfast is available to be purchased/picked-up at Wolford and is served to students in the cafeteria. Social distancing seating will be employed

VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS

MISD will be welcoming Visitors & Volunteers after two weeks of school which will be on September 17th
Be sure to update volunteer application with MISD

Practices & Protocols subject to updates and modifications to ensure the safety of all

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| PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE) | Outside as feasible Minimal equipment use throughout the year Disinfect equipment between classes and individuals Maintain social distancing |
| HALLWAYS | Students will be walking to the far-right in hallways to maintain social distancing and teachers will be spacing students out in the lines |
| LUNCH | Students will eat in the cafeteria and have designated seats to maximize social distancing Signage will be used to skip seats for distancing |
| TEMPERATURE SCREENING | MISD will not be doing temperature checks on every student, rather, teachers will have thermometers and will take the temperatures of students who state that they don't feel well. Also, if there is a confirmed case in a classroom, staff members may take temperatures of students in that classroom as a mitigating measure to closely monitor |

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LEARNING AREAS

Classroom and classroom supplies disinfected throughout and at the end of the day

INFECTION CONTROL PRACTICES

Frequent hand washing throughout the day (especially before eating and after the restroom)
Use soap and water for 20 seconds - include the front and back of the hands, in-between fingers, and fingertips

PARKING LOTS

To maximize traffic flow, both front and back parking lots will be utilized for arrival and dismissal

STAGGERED DISMISSAL

Dismissal times for grade levels to leave classrooms will be staggered to allow for social distancing

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PARENTS NEEDING TO PICK UP THEIR CHILD DURING THE DAY

Parent notifies front office
Regular dismissal sign out
procedures are to be followed
Student is escorted to campus door
upon parent arrival
Students who are ill are to be
dismissed through clinic protocols

RECESS

Students and staff will use hand
sanitizer before entering play
areas and at the end of recess
before building re-entry
Multiple play areas will be utilized
to minimize group sizes

LIBRARY BOOKS FROM WOLFORD

2-5 students will put books on hold and
Learning Commons Staff will deliver books
to students
K-1 students will be offered book choices
and Learning Commons Staff will deliver
books to students
Returned books will be collected and
quarantined for 3 days

STUDENT MASKS/FACE COVERINGS

Ages 10 and above will wear a face covering (over the nose and mouth) wherever it is not feasible to maintain 6 feet of distancing.
A face covering is recommended for ages 3-9 especially in hallways, common areas, buses, and when 6 feet of distancing cannot be maintained, as feasible.
Students may temporarily remove masks to consume food and drink.
Students may temporarily remove to engage in physical activity outdoors while maintaining a safe distance.

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
